As per MCI requirement ICC was included in the Disciplinary Resource Committee /Anti – Ragging Committee by the Principal in Sept. 2017. According to the Gazette Notification Act 2013 the ICC displayed various posters projecting the committee members, and information disseminated to all the departments in the college , hostels ,nursing college and hospital premises. To publicize widely, posters in Hindi and English, have been acquired from National Commission for Women , Delhi and displayed as well. Website UCMS has been informed for a revised display of newly constituted members.

The ICC members have addressed various issues regarding the safety of women employees and students at the work place:

The following activities were held:

1. In the year 2017 the members sensitized the fresh batch 2017 MBBS students and staff members including students (B.Sc & M.Sc,MIT) of Nursing college Deptt on gender related issues by holding interactive sessions with them.
2. An invited guest lecture was held 3rd March, 2017 by POSCHA (Dr. Surbhi Dhingra) on Awareness Programme on Sexual Harassment of Women on Work Place for faculty and non teaching staff members of UCMS.
3. Dr Shruti Srivastava, Professor Psychiatry, UCMS & GTBH delivered a lecture to the nonteaching staff of college on Oct 2017 in LT III. It was attended by 50 non teaching staff.
4. As per UGC notification(Article 15 of the Indian constitution, Govt. of India) , to promote gender equality and foster an environment of equal treatment “ Gender Champion Club” was constituted by seeking nominations of undergraduate students for which a notice was displayed. 15 applications were received wherein students were asked to submit a brief account of their activity during the year in promoting the gender equality..This was submitted to the office of the Principal for necessary action.
5. Annual report of 2016- 2017 was submitted to Distt. Magistrate New Delh and UGC
6. Gender related activities were also held during the Annual UCMS undergraduate Festival “Ripple”2018: Poster making competition: Women-Fighting the Odds. Prize money for first, second, third and consolation prizes were distributed. The first prize cash prize of Rs 2000/- was given to Sudhanshu, 8th semester UCMS; second prize to Devansh, 6th semester UCMS; third cash prize to Anoushka, 6th semester UCMS. For “Gender Championship”- debate competition, first cash prize of Rs. 4000 was given to Utkarsh Dayal and second prize of Rs. 2000 to Sana from UCMS.
7. Parliament questions regarding gender sensitization have been addressed regularly.
8. University college of Medical sciences ,Dilshad garden organized a Gender Championship which was a relay group discussion on 20th March, 2018 on the topics related to Gender Sensitisation
